



## ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

### 1. The Scholarship

- i) The College offers up to four Scholarships to the value of 50% of the tuition fees for academically able students entering Year 7 in 2019 & 2020.
- ii) Each Scholarship is tenable for Year 7, 8, 9, 10 and covers 50% of the standard annual tuition fee given the students meets the set criteria at the end of each year. These criteria will be discussed with parents and students when accepting the Scholarship.
- iii) The Scholarship does not include any other specific purpose charges.
- iv) The Principal reserves the right to withdraw a Scholarship should the recipient underachieve or seriously breach College rules and regulations.
- v) Students who receive an Academic Scholarship must be enrolled in the College Gifted and Talented Program.
- vi) Should the student leave the College prior to the end of Year 10, parents/guardians may be liable for the payment of tuition fees that have been waived under the Scholarship. A decision to charge these fees would be at the discretion of the Principal.

### 2. Applications

- i) Applications are made on line directly from the College website <https://www.emmanuel.wa.edu.au/academic-scholarship>
- ii) Applications close at 4.00pm on the 8 May 2018. Any applications received after this date will not be accepted. Parents will be advised of the time, place and other relevant details of the examination after this date.

### 3. Process of Awarding Scholarships

- i) Scholarships are awarded on the basis of a written examination conducted by the College. Those short listed along with their parents will be interviewed by the Principal who will evaluate the student's suitability, values and ethics for the Scholarship.
- ii) The Principal is responsible for making the final decision and no correspondence will be entered into.
- iii) The Scholarship Examination is administered by College personnel.

### 4. Notification

- i) All applicants will be advised of the outcome.
- ii) Scholarship certificates are presented to the recipients at their school assemblies, if their Primary School Principal grants permission.
