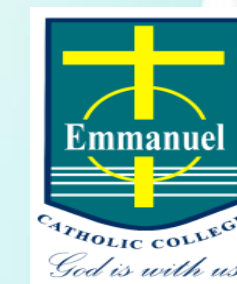

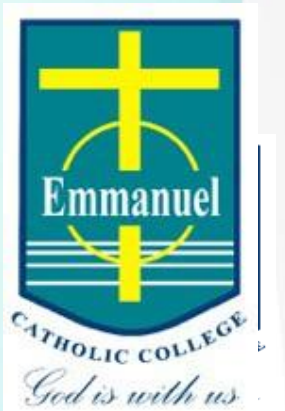

WACE Requirements - 2017

- Completion of 20 units or the equivalent.
- A minimum of 10 Year 12 units or the equivalent.
- Complete at least one pair of course units from both
List A (Arts/Languages/Social Sciences) and List B (Mathematics/Science/Technology) in Year 12



WACE Requirements - 2016

- Achievement of at least 14 C grades (or the equivalent) or higher in Year 11 and 12 units, with a minimum of 6 C grades or the equivalent at Year 12.
- Completion of at least four Year 12 ATAR courses or of a VET Certificate II or higher VET qualification.



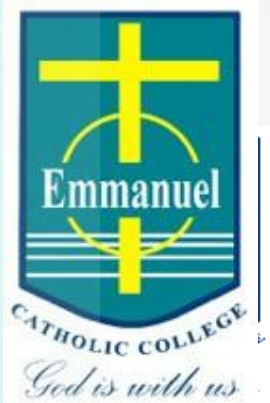
WACE Requirements - 2016

- Completion of at least four units of an English course post Year 10.
- Demonstration of the minimum standard of literacy and numeracy.
- Students must have passed the OLNA.
- Students studying an ATAR course must sit the external exam.



University Entrance

- Secondary Graduation (WACE)
- Competence in English (scaled mark of $\geq 50\%$ in ATAR English or ATAR Literature) *or some other provisions*
- Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) for a specific course.
- Pre-requisites (eg. scaled mark of $\geq 50\%$ in specified course, interview, audition, portfolio)
- Other methods including portfolio entry.



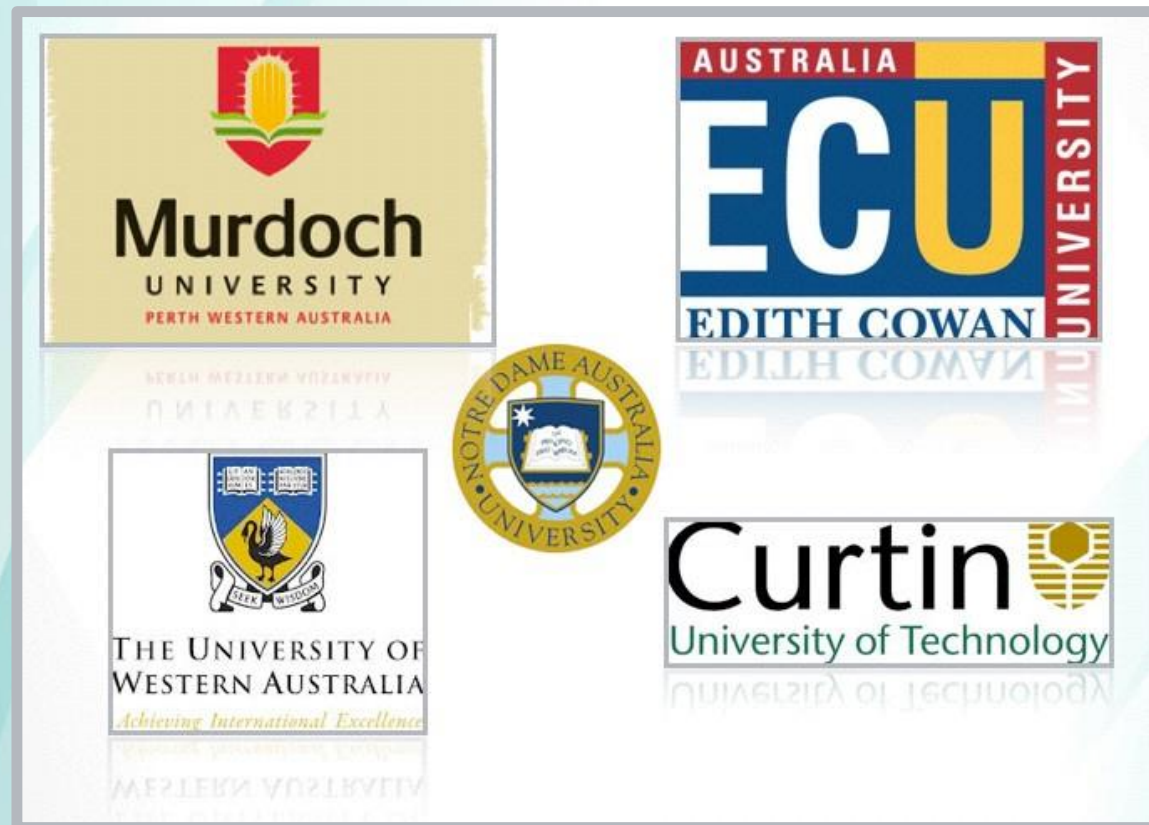
ATAR Rank

- Ranking between 0 and 99.95
- Eg. an ATAR of 91 means a student is equal to, or better than, 91% of the entire Year 12 population in the State.
- Based on the Tertiary Entrance Aggregate (TEA)
- TEA based on:
 - best four Year 12 courses (scaled marks)
 - scaled marks added to give TEA out of 400
 - TEA converted to an ATAR



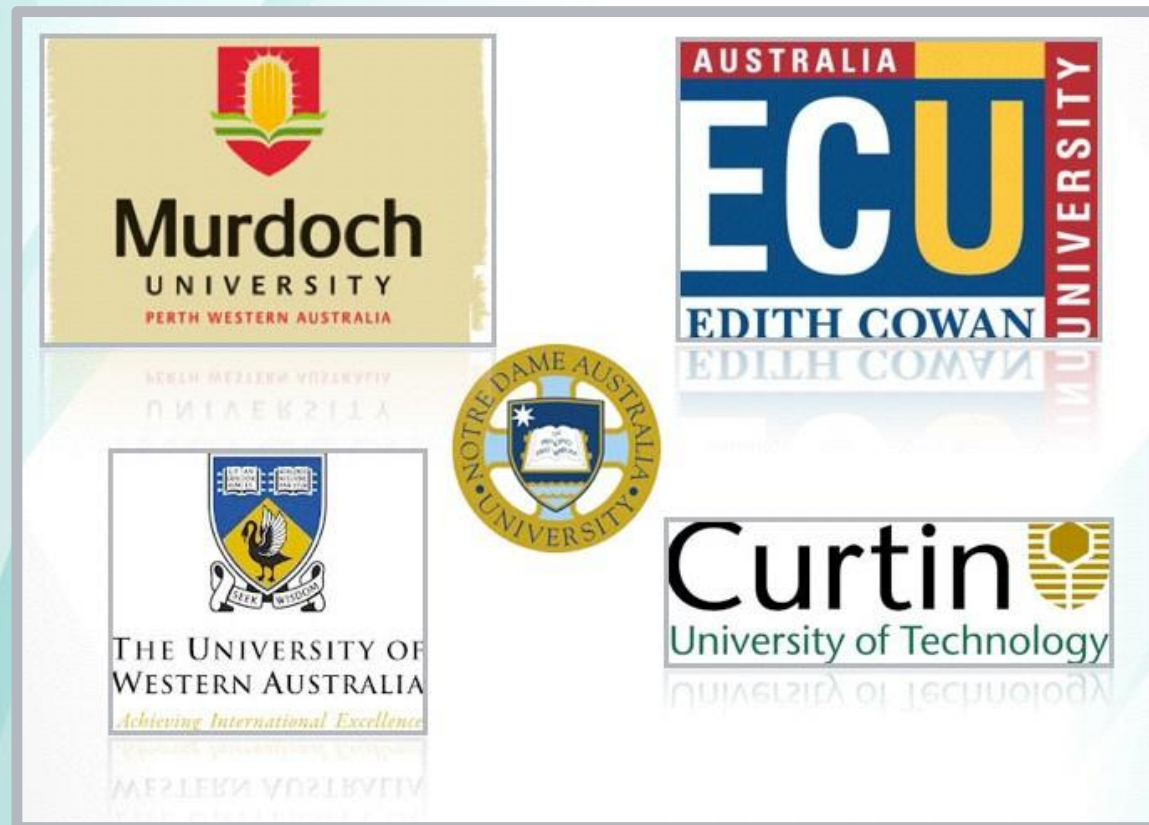

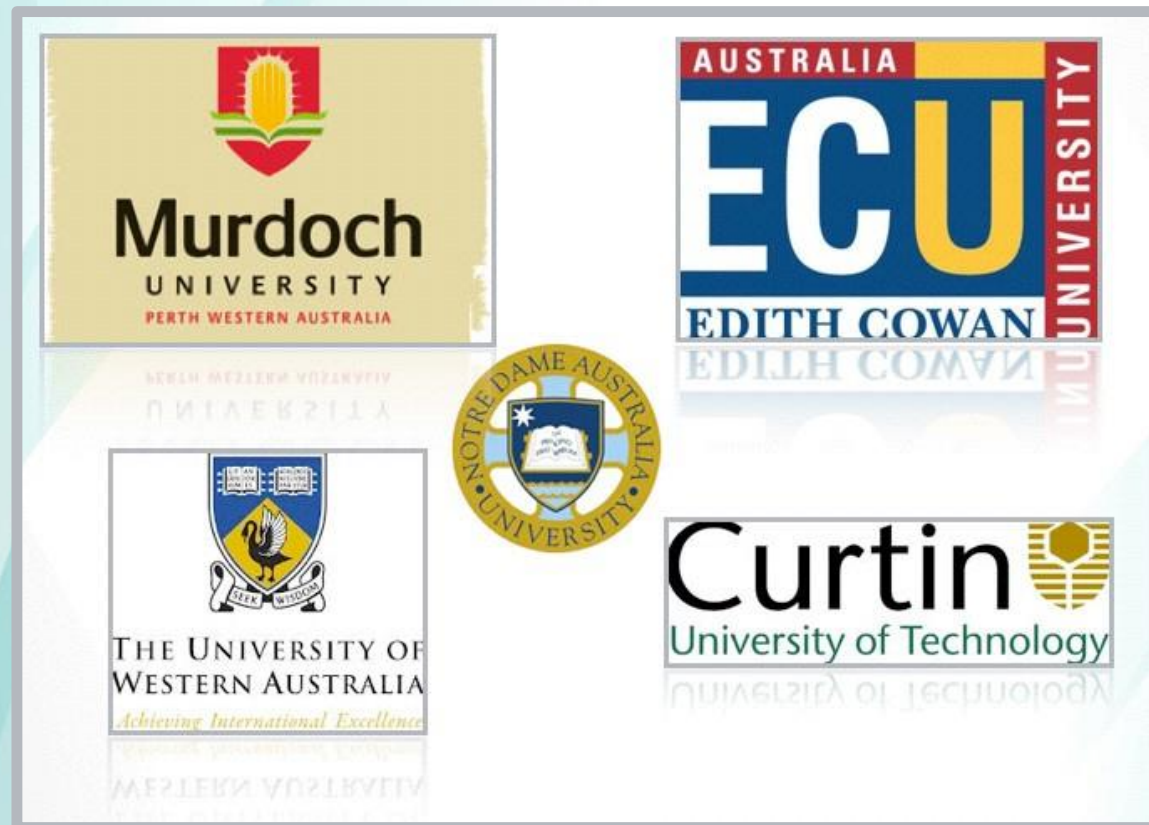

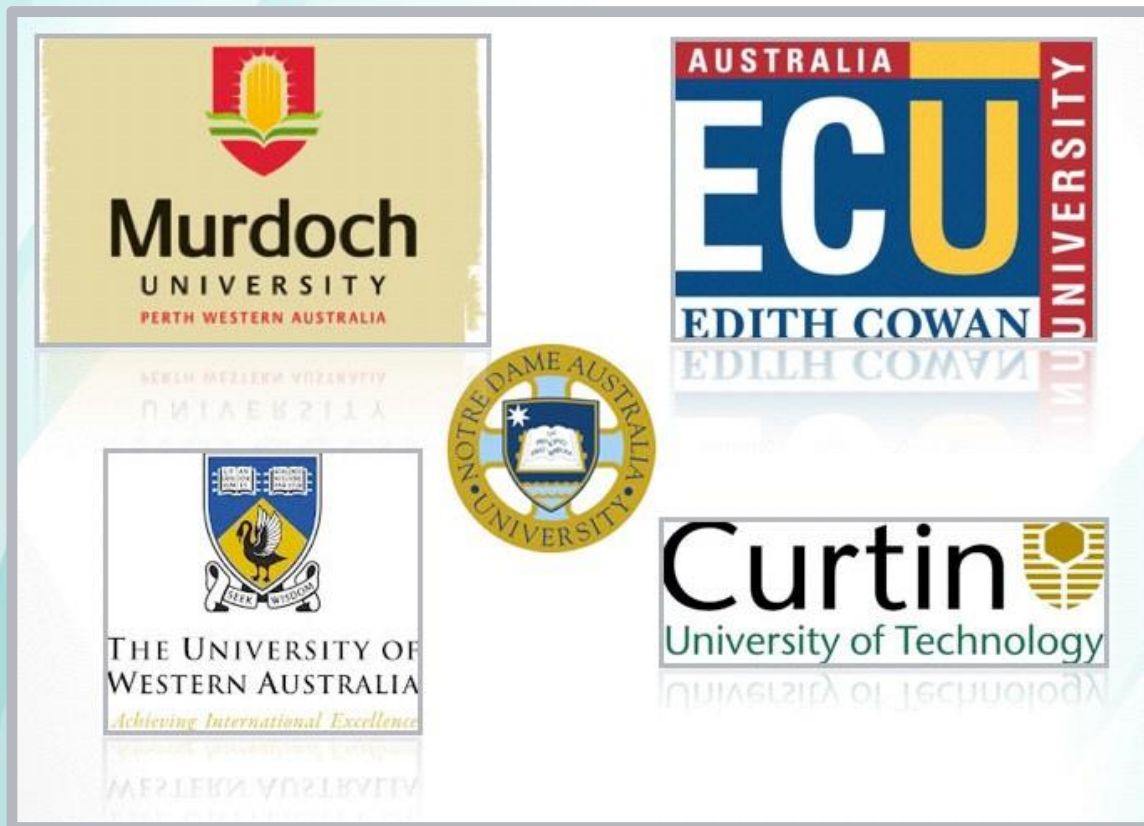

What does it mean?

- You need to be aware of the ATAR score required for your course.
- The ATAR Score is not fixed and varies from year to year.
- Scaling can have an effect on students scores, this is out of our control.
- Student performance at the examination level plays a key role.

ATAR (minimum of about 70)

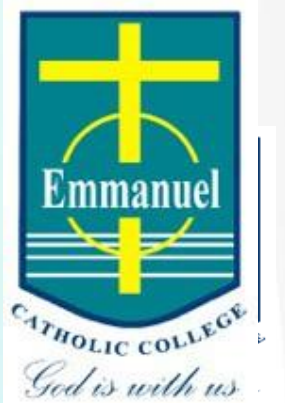

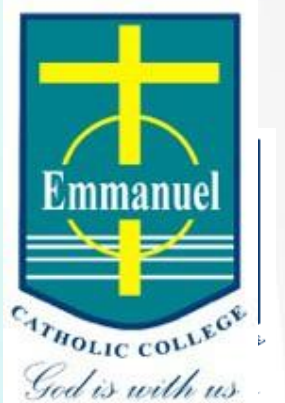
Certificate I-Advanced Diploma

Entry is based on grades achieved in school courses, certificates attained and work experience.

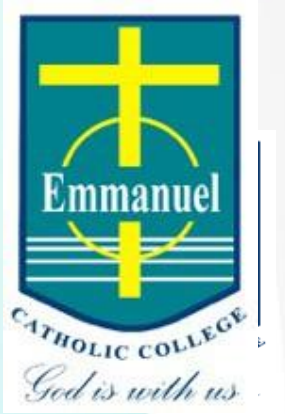

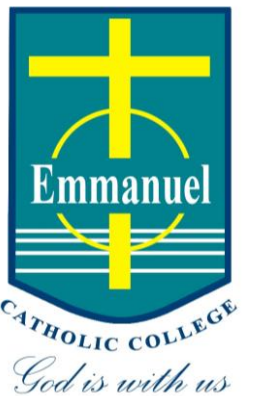
