- A desire to give service to the Emmanuel Catholic College community and the promotion of its vision.
- Ability to work cooperatively and constructively with all other members of the Board.
- A sufficiency of time to devote to Board duties.

The Emmanuel Catholic College Parents and Friends' Association is an opportunity for all parents to become members to be part of a range of activities which contribute to the College. Formal positions available for nomination are Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer and are elected at the Annual Community Meeting. The period of election to the Parents and Friends' Committee is one year, after which positions are declared vacant and a subsequent Executive is elected.
